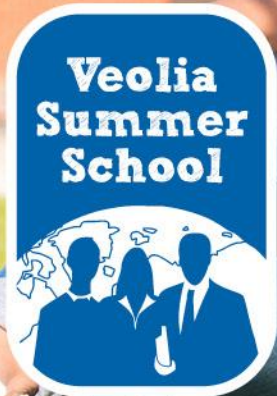

Summer School objectives

- Increase attendants' awareness concerning the environmental stakes for sustainable cities & industry
- Improve Veolia's attractiveness
- Introduce international students to the business and activities related to environmental services
- An opportunity to establish preferential relations with elite universities and business schools
- A way to communicate widely

Modalities

- Initial selection of students by the university you identified locally
- Final selection by Veolia country HR in consultation with the program manager in Paris
- Who can apply?
 - *Students entering their last year of studies in September 2018 (preparing : master degree, engineering diploma, business school diploma, ...) and interested in Veolia*
 - *Fluent in English: all presentations will be held in English*

Travel with some conditions, board and lodgings will be covered by Campus, Veolia.

Content

- Introduction to Veolia, meetings with HR staff, meetings with operations staff, site visits, business case, group discussions, cultural visits...
